



What is the Move-on-When-Ready (MOWR) Program?

- MOWR is a State of Georgia program which provides students the opportunity to earn college credit while enrolled in an accredited high school program and Georgia Perimeter College by providing financial assistance toward their cost of attendance. MOWR is administered by the Georgia Department of Education.

What will MOWR funds provide?

- Tuition for fall and spring semesters for courses in the five core areas. The full list can be viewed at http://www.gsfc.org/main/publishing/pdf/2005/accel_courses.pdf.
- HOPE mandatory fees (additional fees may be required that are not covered by MOWR).

Am I eligible for MOWR funds? Yes, if...

- You are a High School junior or senior currently enrolled in a HOPE-eligible high school program, you attended this high school during the preceding school year, and you are accepted into the Dual Enrollment Program with Georgia Perimeter College.

AND

- You are a U.S. citizen or U.S. national or have permanent resident status at the time the application is submitted and you are considered a resident of the State of Georgia.

How do I participate?

- Complete Part I of the MOWR application available from your high school.
- Be sure to verify your Social Security Number and answer all questions.
- Have your high school counselor complete Part II of the application.
- Turn Parts I and II of the application into your Dual Enrollment coordinator. We will complete Part III and send the application to the Georgia DOE.
- Register with Selective Service if you are a male over 18; you need to do this before completing the MOWR application.

When do I have to submit my MOWR application?

- A MOWR application must be submitted by week two of classes each semester.
- A new MOWR form must be completed each semester.
