intro

Georgia Perimeter College, the largest associate degree-granting college and the third largest institution in the University System of Georgia, was founded by the citizens of DeKalb County and the DeKalb Board of Education in 1958 and became a college in 1964. GPC has five convenient locations along the major access corridors of metropolitan Atlanta.

Since its inception in 1983 as a private, nonprofit organization, the Georgia Perimeter College Foundation has had one goal: to serve, support and promote the students, faculty and staff of GPC.

The Foundation trustees manage its assets and help raise private support for GPC. The Foundation provides student scholarships based on need and academic achievement, supports student programs, funds academic initiatives and allows GPC to provide professional growth opportunities, awards and incentives for outstanding faculty and staff.

CAN I APPLY FOR MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP?

Yes. While we encourage students to apply for multiple scholarships, you should be aware that if you are awarded two scholarships to cover full tuition and book expenses for the academic year, you can only accept one. Please be certain that prior to applying for a GPC Foundation scholarship you have communicated with a Financial Aid counselor about how scholarship funds can impact other types of financial assistance you may receive. It is best to speak with a professional in the Financial Aid office at GPC to address these issues.

CAN I RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP IF I DON'T HAVE A FINANCIAL NEED?

Yes. Many Georgia Perimeter College scholarships are not need-based.

WILL I BE NOTIFIED IF I RECEIVE THE SCHOLARSHIP?

Yes. You will receive notification from the scholarship manager and a letter from the Institutional Advancement office within the semester that you have applied.

WILL I BE NOTIFIED IF I DON'T RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP?

Yes. The scholarship manager will notify you. However, please stay in touch with the department where you turned in your application.

HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY SCHOLARSHIP?

Your scholarship money will be posted to your student account during the semester following the application deadline. It is important that we receive accurate student information.

CAN I APPLY ONLINE?

No, but you can view information about scholarships and download an application online at www.gpc.edu on the

Foundation home page under the "Student Scholarships" link or in paper format at any Financial Aid office.

HOW DO I GET MY TRANSCRIPT?

You can visit the Admissions office on your campus or fill out a request form online at www.gpc.edu.

WHAT IS A FINANCIAL NEED STATEMENT?

You may visit our Web site at <http://www.gpc.edu/Foundation/scholarships.htm> to download the Financial Need Statement form, which outlines your income and expenses. There is also a section that allows you to explain how you would benefit from being awarded this scholarship, how you are currently financing your education, difficulties you have faced paying for your education, any family or personal challenges making it harder for you to pay for college and what you would gain from this scholarship.

ESSAY

Some of our Georgia Perimeter College Foundation scholarships require students to write an essay. It may help to think of writing an essay as a scholarship interview. You must convince the committee that you need or deserve the scholarship.

Preparing to write your essay:

Think about the question and create an outline that answers the question. Ask yourself, "Did I answer the question?"

Make a list of your achievements/accomplishments (e.g., you were named "volunteer of the month," have perfect attendance or published a writing assignment).

Make a list of personal strengths, challenges and obstacles you have overcome or are currently confronting.

Include three to five pieces of information you think the committee should know about you.

Review your essay.

Proofread, proofread, proofread! Have someone else read your work!

Make your essay interesting.

FIVE STEPS TO APPLY FOR A GPC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

STEP 1

Complete your FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). All GPC students should turn in a copy of their FAFSA report with their application packets. You can find the necessary documents at: www.fafsa.ed.gov and receive help in completing your FAFSA from a financial aid officer on any GPC campus.

STEP 2

Review all the GPC scholarships described in the 2010 Scholarship booklet, and select the ones for which you qualify. Take note of deadlines, required supporting documents and the location/person to whom the application and other materials should be sent.

STEP 3

Make multiple copies of the GPC scholarship application, using one blank application for each scholarship for which you are applying. Take your time and complete the application. Give yourself plenty of time to collect necessary documents before the deadline date.

STEP 4

Keep a copy of your application and materials for your own records.

STEP 5

Review your scholarship package before sending it to the specified scholarship manager. If you are mailing your application, ask the postmaster to stamp/meter your envelope in your presence so the postmark is legible. Application packets must be postmarked no later than the application deadline specified.

* International students are not required to complete the FAFSA.

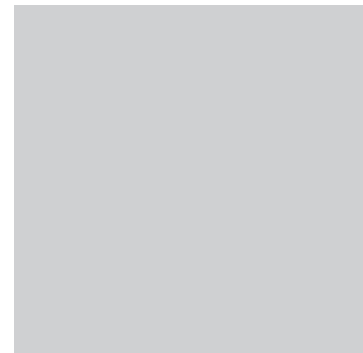
