PRE-WORKSHOP RECORDING ASSIGNMENT – Needs to be completed by January 15, 2007

As part of this workshop, you will be required to record a selected text for use during our time. We will be using the GPC sign language lab for the workshop.

The workshop will focus on independent study ideas and self analysis. This recording will “Kick-Start” you on your way.

If you are able to record your interpretation at home or another site, that will be fine. It will need to be recorded to CD-R. We will also give you access to our sign language interpreting lab to make your recording if you need it.

RECORDING

- Here is the link to the selected text you will interpret <http://www.learner.org/> to access this site.
- From the home page, look to the left menu bar and click on “FREE video on demand” this will lead you to a sign up page.
- You will have to sign up with the website and create a user account. Very simple to do, all you need is an email account so obtain access.
- Once you have signed in, click the top tabs “view programs”.
- From there use the drop down menus and select
 - By discipline – science
 - By grade- college/adult
 - Click go
- Scroll down and click “Rediscovering Biology: Molecular to Global Perspectives”
- Open “**Session 6. HIV and AIDS**” by clicking the  icon
- The video that comes up will be the text you interpret.

If you would prefer you may use the sign language lab for your recording you may do so. The lab is on the Clarkston campus D building room CD 1180. You must contact Becky Thurman to set up an appointment. GUIDELINES FOR RECORDING

Whether you record in the lab or another location, you will be required to record using a CD-R. The recording is a little under 30 Minutes. Please bring a CD-R with you or you may purchase one from the lab for \$1.00.

The lab assistant will be available to help you with the recordings. The selected text will be on our computers, you will wear headphones, and perform your recording. You will need to bring this recording with you to the workshop.

Please do the recording COLD, DO NOT view it and then prepare your interpretation. Remember proper dress so the recording will be visible. Please avoid wearing RED.
